2011 marks the 120th anniversary for the Giulio Cocchi Spumanti company, and to celebrate they have resumed production of Giulio Cocchi's Vermouth di Torino first made in 1891. The company claims to that the sweet vermouth is made according to the original recipe with Moscato wine sourced from the Asti region, outside Turin.

**Tasting:** Clear, brownish-red. The fruity, spicy nose has citrus, chocolate, Indian spice, hot cinnamon, smoked crispy bacon and menthol aromas. The huge, complex, fruity, raisin palate has an underlying spicy, citrusy bitterness over which are layered sweet flavours of liquorice, orange zest and juice, rhubarb, grapes, and cocoa. Slight smokiness to the lingering, quinine, bitter-sweet finish with a slight hint of curry spice. 4.5/5
